Connectivity, collaboration and cybersecurity challenges of remote work

From endpoint devices to Wi-Fi networks to video conferencing apps and call center solutions, the technology your remote teams use can either enable productivity and security—or hinder them.

Despite employees describing equal or higher levels of productivity at home, many still report being hampered because of weak or nonexistent internet **connectivity**.⁵

65%

of survey respondents who had transitioned to working or schooling remotely experienced frozen or dropped video calls.

reported being forced to use phones as a hotspot.

According to the 2022 Mobile Security Index, when it comes to **cybersecurity**, a dispersed workforce and an increased reliance on mobile devices for hybrid work purposes create more targets for hackers and data breaches—which can translate into hefty fines and damage to reputation.⁷

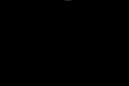

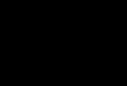
